Happy Are The Mourners

The Bible reminds us that Jesus was acquainted with grief and sorrow. We see glimpses of His anger, frustration, disappointment and fatigue throughout His ministry. We are witnesses to graphic depictions of His personal struggles, including His temptation in the wilderness and His groanings at Gethsemane. And, ultimately, we see the excruciating pain of the Cross.

However, we are told that Jesus endured the Cross with joy set before Him. We see Him in other places rejoicing in the Spirit. He attends a wedding and turns the water into wine. He marvels at the faith of some, to the point of joyous exclamation. He nestles little children in His bosom and seems to convey an attractive personality.

Jesus enjoyed a wonderful balance. He knew that His sufferings had purpose. He chose to rejoice when the opportunities presented themselves, yet He allowed Himself to grieve under the appropriate circumstances. He rejoiced at a wedding and wept at a tomb. He celebrated Passover with His friends and struggled alone at Gethsemane.

Jesus knew pain, but that did not prevent Him from enjoying life, ministry and friends.

There's A Group For Everyone

As a church body we make our home in Times Square, just east of Hell's Kitchen. We have trusted the Lord to make us a beacon there--a focal point of life, love and the transforming truth of the gospel. Over the years our neighbors have changed. The seedy shops have given way to high-end retail stores and restaurants. People have come through our doors and others have gone. The culture has shifted in countless ways around us.

In the midst of everything that has transformed, we have clung to what we know will never grow old, irrelevant or obsolete: Jesus Christ and His life, death and resurrection.

Our youth leader, Tony Ghelan and his team are responsible for young people between the ages of 13 and 29. Over the last several months, they have been working to redefine the youth and young adults ministry to draw, disciple and lead them to discover their identity and purpose in Jesus Christ.

The Gate now meets on the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month at 7:30PM, for young adults ages 18-29. On the 1st and 3rd Fridays, young adults will break into connect groups meeting around the city. Each connect group has a different social focus. *Amplify*, for example, is a group that connects young adults with musical and poetic skills, while *Adventures in NYC* connects young adults who want to explore our city together. There are currently nine connect groups. Each group will also read the Bible and discuss faith-related issues together.

Pray for us as we move forward with these exciting new changes. The ultimate vision is that young people would be connected to one another and be connected to Jesus Christ. We are not meant to live the Christian life in failure or in loneliness. Together we will serve the Lord. ☑

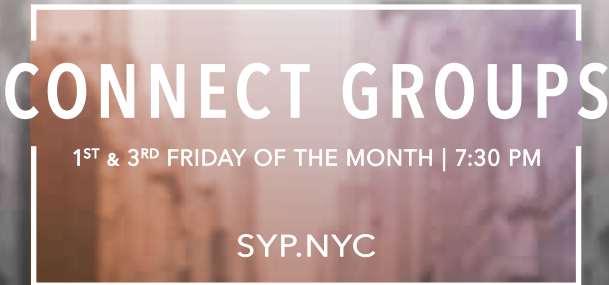
