Pastor's Note



Oh, Magnify the Lord with Me

A lost art in the modern church is personal praise. We have congregational song services and we enjoy music CDs, but prayerfully and verbally acknowledging the goodness of God and recounting His faithfulness in our daily conversations seems to be seen as impractical at best, and hyper-spiritual, if not hypocritical at worst. As a result, many are actually ashamed to magnify the Lord in settings outside of the four walls of the church. But the Holy Scriptures and the Holy Spirit invite us to testify to the glory of God and to rejoice in His words, works and ways.

I once taught a session in which I finally invited Christians to actively and daily celebrate the sacrifice of Christ. One person who evaluated the teaching suggested that while the study was well done, I had left the audience with no real practical advice.

Imagine a church scenario where reminding people of the peace, passion, privilege, propriety and priority of praise is considered impractical, vacuous or meaningless. And while congregational song services are wonderful, and CDs are helpful, personal praise is vital, vibrant and essential.

WALK THE TALK

August 1-4

From Tuesday, August 1 through Friday, August 4, Times Square Church is taking to the streets with "Walk the Talk," a week of practical outreaches to serve people and show the love of Jesus. "Walk the Talk," is one of the local offerings on the TSC Missions trip schedule. The best part is you don't have to pack a bag—just prepare your heart to be a benefit to others.

This is the second year for "Walk the Talk," and this year we are turning our attention from the five boroughs of New York City, to our very own neighborhood, the 10-block radius of Times Square Church.

Every morning the group will meet at the church for training and prayer before spending the afternoon practicing what was learned about serving this community. Some of the topics in the training include: "spying out the land," "being a cup of cold water," and "stopping for the one."

After four inspiring days of learning, serving and evangelism, the week will culminate in Faith Day! A day of baseball followed by a worship and prayer service after the final out of the Mets vs. Dodgers game. The Times Square Church Choir will sing the national anthem and lead worship. There will be testimonies from Mets players and a faith-based message by Pastor Carter Conlon.
